GENERAL INFORMATION

PLEASE READ THIS INFORMATION VERY CAREFULLY

The University provides excellent and sustainable financial support packages for prospective as well as registered students with academic potential and clear-cut plans for the future. Undergraduate bursaries are available for both academic and non-academic achievement. Bursaries and loans are awarded on the grounds of both academic achievement and financial need.

The University considers applications for financial assistance from students who are South African citizens or permanent residents. From 2008, enrolled students with citizenship in SADC countries will be considered for UP undergraduate achievement bursaries provided they meet the criteria. For UP postgraduate bursaries non-South African citizens are also considered for awards.

In addition to bursaries and loans published in this brochure, details of other bursaries and loans that are made available from time to time are displayed on the bulletin boards of the various faculties concerned. You are also advised to watch the media for bursaries offered by external organisations. You are advised to apply for all the bursaries you qualify for, as well as for study loans.

Prospective students must first apply for admission to the University. An application for study financing may be submitted only after a student number has been allocated.

UP bursaries are fully repayable should bursary holders change, fail, discontinue or terminate the study programme at any stage during the year in which the bursary has been granted. If students do not pass at least 50% of the subjects initially registered for during the first semester, half of the bursary amount will be cancelled. The full amount will be cancelled if the student does not write the year-end exam.

Students previously registered at other universities must submit a complete academic record along with their application form. Awarding of bursaries and loans is done during the first semester. Any application on which there is outstanding documentation or information will not be processed.

No bursaries will be awarded to students following a special study programme.

Credit on student accounts that result from UP bursaries may be claimed in writing at the Client Service Centre during the second semester.

The University reserves the right to amend, without prior notice, the regulations and conditions applicable to the allocation of bursaries and loans.

GENERAL INFORMATION

PLEASE READ THIS INFORMATION VERY CAREFULLY

REGISTRATION

An initial payment must be made before a student will be allowed to enrol at the University. UP achievement bursaries **cannot be utilised for the payment thereof.**

STUDENT ACCOUNTS

Student accounts are payable in **three** instalments of which the compulsory payment at registration is regarded as the first instalment. The second instalment is due by the end of April and the final instalment by the end of July.

A special discount is offered to students who settle their student accounts **in full** before the end of March. Please note that this discount is calculated i.r.o. the personal contribution and thus excludes the portion covered by the bursary.

The values of the bursaries advertised in this brochure are subject to change.

The University reserves the right to amend without prior notice, the regulations and conditions applicable to the awarding of bursaries and loans.

PART I :

BURSARIES AND LOANS OFFERED AND AWARDED BY THE UNIVERSITY

1. BURSARIES

1.1 UNDERGRADUATE BURSARIES

1.1.1 ACHIEVEMENT BURSARIES (ACADEMIC)

• SENIOR UNDERGRADUATE STUDENTS

The following criteria is applicable to the awarding of achievement bursaries to **senior undergraduate students**:

1. Achievement bursaries will be awarded automatically to registered senior undergraduate students that qualifies for the bursary and who are South African citizens or permanent residents or has citizenship in a SADC country.
2. Students that achieved an average **of at least 75%** (figures not rounded off) for qualifying modules per study programme will qualify for the bursary, provided that the requirements as per par 4 below, has been met.
3. Undergraduate contact education students whom were registered for an undergraduate study programme in the previous year of study at the UP will be considered for the bursary.
4. Modules will be weighted. Year modules will count 4 points; semester modules will count 2 points and quarter modules will count 1 point. To determine the number of equivalent year modules that a student is registered for, the sum of the weighted modules is divided by 4.
 - a. Students (excluding students at the Faculty for Veterinary Science) with a weighted module point of less than 12 (less than 3 equivalent year modules) will be excluded.
 - b. For study at the Faculty of Veterinary Science students will be excluded if the weighted module point is less than 8 (less than 2 equivalent year modules).
5. The following is **excluded** if the student was registered during the previous year of study for the following:
 - a. UP study programmes presented by external institutions (where the programme code > 13000000)
 - b. Postgraduate study programmes (where the 3rd character of the study program code is not equal to 1)
 - c. Special study programmes (where the 4th character of the study program is equal to 8 or 9)
 - d. Study programmes classified as distance education programmes.
6. The following students are **excluded**:
 - a. Students that, during the previous year of study, achieved a promotion symbol equal to "D".
 - b. International students (students who are not SA citizens or do not have permanent residency in SA)
 - c. Senior undergraduate students that migrated to UP from other educational institutions.

• **SENIOR UNDERGRADUATE STUDENTS (continued)**

7. Summer / Winter programmes with module results are **included** for purposes of achievement bursary awards.
8. When calculating the average (sum of the valid module results divided by number of modules) and for the weighting action the following modules are excluded:
 - a) All postgraduate modules (figure part of module is > than 700)
 - b) Final mark during withdrawal period equals 0;
 - c) Modules with post code equal to 2 or 9;
 - d) Modules where exemption has been granted (on grounds of final point 990/991/974/975/978)
 - e) Attendance modules (tested by module activity as well as final points 996/997) as well as 'subject active' 5.6 and 7.
 - f) Modules that have been discontinued - 998. If a module has been terminated before cut off date – final point 998,
 - g) All modules not be taken into consideration for 'Golden key" allocations (Cil, EOT etc)
 - h) Modules presented in distance education (when the variable modulus = A)
 - i) UNISA modules enrolled by Mamelodi pipeline students – (if OE code of the module = 1677)
 - j) Module subscription for modules not considered for HEMIS (subsidy)
9. Modules with the following final mark codes will be calculated as follows when considering achievement bursaries:
 - a) Code 953 - pass presentation > 68% = 69%
 - b) Code 973 (Promoted) = sem/year/promotion mark
 - c) Code 976 (credit forfeited) = 0
 - d) Code 987 (Absent from exams) = 0
 - e) Code 988 (Exam refusal) = 0
 - f) Code 989 (Exam result not available) =0
 - g) Code 992(Sub minimum in exam not obtained) = 39
 - h) Code 993 (exemption from exams) - repeaters = promotion mark
 - i) Code 995 (Exam not completed postgraduate) =0
 - j) Code 998 (Module terminated) =0
10. Students that completed a first undergraduate study programme and returns for another undergraduate study programme, may be considered again for a senior undergraduate achievement bursary, provided that the student meets the qualification rules.
11. Students that are simultaneously registered for two or more undergraduate study programmes will only be considered for one achievement bursary. In this case the study programme in which the student achieved the highest marks will be considered.
12. An achievement bursary for a senior undergraduate student will be awarded for (N-1) times in relation to the period of study for which the student is enrolled. "N" represents the minimum allowable period of study for completion of the study programme.
13. An achievement bursary for a senior undergraduate student can only automatically be awarded for a maximum of five times. Should a student qualify for more than five awards during the period of study, the Division for Study Finance will evaluate each award individually, subject to the availability of funding.

• SENIOR UNDERGRADUATE STUDENTS (continued)

14. Undergraduate students that discontinue their studies for a year or more, will during the year in which they return to continue their studies, not qualify for the bursary.
15. **Bursary values** are quoted as follows:

• NEW UNDERGRADUATE STUDENTS

- The University of Pretoria make undergraduate achievement bursaries available to new first-year students undertaking further study for the first time after completing the Grade 12 examination
- Undergraduate achievement bursaries will be awarded automatically to registered new undergraduate students that qualifies for the bursary and who are South African citizens or permanent residents or has citizenship in a SADC country.
- Prospective students who qualify for an achievement bursary will automatically be considered for the bursary. They need not apply and there is no closing date.
- The **criterion for bursaries** for new first-year students is the average of the six highest percentages obtained for the subjects passed on the higher grade. For students who passed less than six subjects on the higher grade, the highest percentages obtained for subjects on the standard grade are taken into account in order to include six subjects in total for each student. However, the percentages obtained for subjects on the standard grade are adjusted downwards by 10% for this purpose. The average % is not rounded off.
- Students who obtained more than six distinctions for subjects on the higher grade, receive R1 000 for each additional distinction obtained for these subjects.
- The awarding of bursaries is finalised on the basis of the final marks that the University receives from the education departments. Results obtained for papers that have been re-marked are not taken into account for this purpose.
- New undergraduates who enrol for degree courses should obtain the following **minimum average** in order to be eligible for a bursary:

1.1.2 TOP ACHIEVER BURSARIES

UP offers bursaries to top prospective student achievers. No application is required for these bursaries.

1. The top new first year students that enrol at UP

- A bursary to the value of R17 500 will be awarded to each of the top 20 new first year students that register at UP.
- The Division for Study Finance will identify the students that qualify for the award, using the criteria for new undergraduate achievement bursaries.

2. Junior Tukkies development programme

- A bursary to the value of R10 000 will be awarded to the top 15 learners with the best grade 12 results who attended the Junior Tukkies Development Programme (the programme is exclusively for previously disadvantaged learners) and are admitted to study a degree programme in the Faculties of Natural and Agricultural Sciences, Health Sciences and Engineering, Built Environment and IT at the University of Pretoria will qualify for the bursary.

3. Top Grade 12 (Dux) scholars at top feeder schools

- An amount equal to the initial payment required during registration will be awarded to at least 70 of the dux scholars at top feeder schools.

The awards are in addition to the UP undergraduate achievement bursary award and will only be made once the learner qualifying for the award is accepted by and enrolls at UP for study. Only SA citizens qualify for these awards.

The bursaries are fully repayable should bursary holders change, fail, discontinue or terminate the study programme at any stage during the year in which the bursary has been granted. If students do not pass at least 50% of the subjects initially registered for during the first semester, half of the bursary amount will be cancelled. The full amount will be cancelled if the student does not write the year-end exam.

1.2 POSTGRADUATE BURSARIES

1.2.1 UP SCHOLARSHIPS FOR POSTGRADUATE STUDIES

Postgraduate students (SA citizens and non-SA citizens) are automatically considered for a UP postgraduate scholarship once they have been accepted for admission by the Faculty (no application for a bursary required). Bursary awards are subject to approval by the Research Committees and are not guaranteed. Preference is given to students that register for research masters- and doctoral degree programmes.

Postgraduate students must register for their relevant study programs by 31 July of the year in which the award is made in order to be considered for an award. Masters- and Doctoral students who register after 31 July will be considered for a scholarship in the following year of their studies.

For scholarships awarded at Honours- or Masters level, students are only considered for a scholarship if they have achieved an average of at least 60% in the preceding degree programme or have a level of performance that is considered equivalent by the Faculty Research Committee.

- For scholarships awarded at Honours level, the average mark is based on all modules that were successfully completed in a previous degree programme at B-level. Modules on final year level or higher are considered. Modules for special study programmes (including diplomas and certificates) as well as study programmes that do not qualify for subsidy purposes are not taken into consideration. All qualifying modules where an examination mark between 50- and 100% were achieved, is used to calculate a weighted accounting average with weights of 4, 2 and 1 respectively for year-, semester- and quarter modules.
- For scholarships awarded at Masters level, the average mark is based on all modules that were successfully completed in a relevant previous degree programme and where an examination mark between 50- and 100% were achieved. Modules for special study programmes (including diplomas and certificates) as well as study programmes that do not qualify for subsidy purposes are not taken into consideration. If more than two degrees were successfully completed on a previous level, the average of the latest study programme will be considered. If the previous degree was successfully completed on a postgraduate level, the accounting average of the qualifying modules will be calculated. If the previous degree was successfully completed on B-level, the average will be calculated as for awards at Honours level.
- The latest examination mark is considered. Where qualifying modules are repeated, the latest result will be considered.
- Averages will not be rounded off.

For scholarships awarded at Doctoral level, eligibility will be determined by the Faculty admissions committee, and a candidate who has been admitted will be eligible for the award of a postgraduate scholarship.

1.2.1 UP SCHOLARSHIPS FOR POSTGRADUATE STUDIES (continued)

Scholarship awards are made by the Faculty's Research Committee. Both the bursary holder and the supervisor should complete the prescribed agreement form in full. The form should be submitted to the Client Service Centre or the administration offices at satellite campuses.

Upon receipt of the agreement form, the full amount of the scholarship is credited to the student's account. The scholarship is first used to cover tuition fees in full. A credit balance will only be paid out upon the receipt of an application form for the disbursement.

Scholarships are awarded once only for a postgraduate study programme. Students who hold a postgraduate qualification will not be considered for a scholarship for postgraduate study at the same level (e.g. students who enrol for a second or even a third honours degree, Masters Degree or Doctoral programme).
